
- 1. Due to the pandemic, students should take all the preventive measures and avoid taking off their masks during activities.

You are strongly advised to encourage your children to take part in the school picnic as they can share the fun with teachers and peers. If students have decided not to join the school picnic, parents should inform the school officially with a written document and your children need to return to school with neat school uniforms and do revision at the designated room from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The recess time and lunch time will be the same as the normal school days. If students are absent on the school picnic day, a medical document is required. If not, students may be considered as skipping classes. If you have any questions, please contact the class teachers.

2. Wearing winter school uniforms

If you have not prepared the winter school uniform for your children, you are advised to buy the uniforms from our uniform providers, Victoria Uniform (Address: Unit B, 4/F, 3 Kin Kwan St., Winfield Industrial Building, Tuen Mun, N.T. Tel: 36919897) and Wa Fung Uniform Company (Address: Workshop 8, 17/F, Kwong Kin Trade Centre, No.5 Kin Fat Street, Tuen Mun Tel: 21170272). As it takes time, parents are advised to prepare the winter uniforms earlier.



Students are allowed to wear either summer or winter school uniforms from 22nd November to 9th December.

Students must wear winter school uniforms on 12th December and onwards.

3. Adopting a half-day schedule on 25th Nov

There will be a staff meeting scheduled on 25th November, Day 7, Friday in the afternoon. A half-day schedule will be adopted on that day. Students will complete all 8 sessions in the morning and the school ending time is 1:35 p.m.

4. Subscription of Chinese Composition Exercise Book

Starting from this year, all students will use manuscript paper by horizontal lines to complete Chinese writing. All students must buy one copy and it costs HK\$6 each.


6. Online application for the Discretionary Places of F.1 Admission

Interested parents should complete the online application form between 3rd January and 17th January. Established in 1987, thanks to the efforts by teachers and students and the support from parents and people in the community, our school is well-developed and students can excel in both academic and non-academic achievements. To adapt to the fine-tuning language policy introduced by EDB since 2010 for catering the needs of students, our school runs classes with English as the medium of instructions with subjects excluding Chinese Language, Chinese History, Putonghua, Life and Society and Religious Education. We also run classes with English as the medium of instructions in subjects of English Language, Mathematics and Science.
