Assemble at 9:15 a.m. Exit F, MTR Siu Hong Station

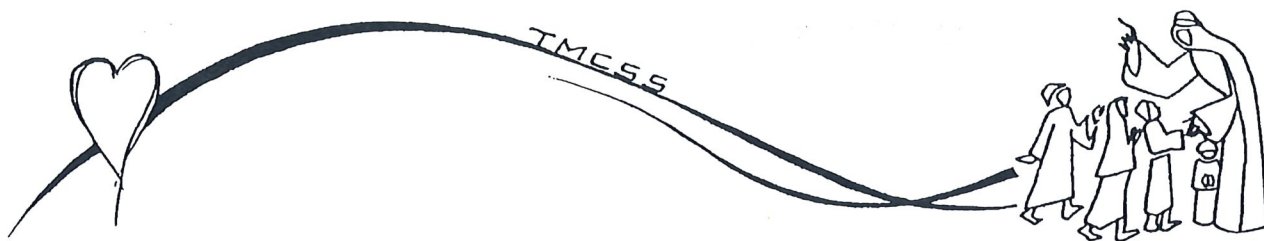

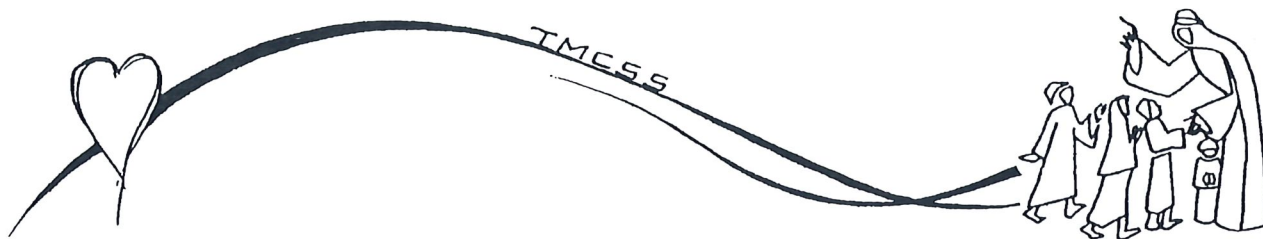
### 7. Typhoon Club English Magazine Writing Workshop

Venue: The course will take place at home with ZOOM

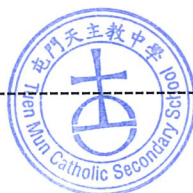


Fee: Free of charge
