3. Invitation to Book Fair and Authors Sharing Sessions


Tuen Teen Book Fair is our traditional annual event, in which teachers recommend books and introduce different authors and genres. We aim to nurture students with good reading habits and widen their horizons. Our theme is 'Innovative Technology Loves Reading'. Books including Chinese Language, English Language, Language Across Curriculum are available. The books cover topics such as Religious Studies, Literatures, Humanities, Natural Science and so on. Parents are also advised to read books about parent-child communication, information technology, cooking, planting and so on. 20% off is offered to Chinese books and 15% off is offered to English books. There are also books with special discounts. Parents are cordially invited to come and read with your children. If you are not available to come, you are advised to support your children to buy books and nurture their reading habits.


4. Running Applied Learning Programmes

Applied Learning (ApL) is one of the elective subjects in the senior form curriculum. The programmes incorporate both theories and practicum, aiming at widening students' horizons in some professions and establishing the connection between students and the fields. Students can learn some basic theories and concepts, develop some job-related skills and boost generic competences. Generally speaking, the duration of the programmes lasts for 2 academic years including F.5 and F.6.

The current F.4 students can consider taking ApL programmes in F.5 and a briefing session was held on 4th January, 2023 so as to let students be more familiar with the course features and how the curriculum helps their further studies and future career. Interested students should submit the application form (as attached) to the collection box available in the General Office on or before 13th March. Successful applicants will be nominated by school after the interview. 5. English Language Enhancement Programme

In order to boost students' competence in reading and listening, an English Enhancement Programme is run for F.4 students. The programme is taught by our alumni studying in universities. Course materials will be given and it is not necessary to purchase other materials in the course. The course fee is \$500 and \$250 will be subsidized by the school. As there is a limited number of participants, student performance will be one of the criteria for the admission.

6. Hall assembly

The event will take place on 8th March (Day 6) in Sessions 7 and 8 and the theme is 'A sharing session by professionals'.

7. 5-Day Singapore Study Tour

Our school will run a 5-Day Singapore Study Tour from 12th April to 16th April (during Easter Holiday). The tour is jointly organized by English Department and Tourism and Hospitality Studies. The itinerary covers knowledge in the curriculum and a chance to exchange ideas with local students in English. Students studying Tourism and Hospitality Studies will have the priority in the selection process. The maximum number of participants is 40. The tour fee is \$10360. School will subsidize students according to their economic situation: (1) Student whose family is supported by Comprehensive Social Security Assistance or full grant for Textbook Subsidy should pay \$2590; (2) Student with half grant supported will pay \$4144; (3) Other students (not supported by the above allowances) will pay \$9324. If your son or daughter is interested in it, please tell them to approach Mr. Lai Chi Yuen, the vice principal or Ms Lee Kit Ling. The application form is also available in eClass. Parents are advised to refer to the detailed information. All applicants will be invited to attend an interview.

8. Purchase of English Fiction

In order to practise how to complete School-based Assessment, our English teachers have subscribed the book 'Wonder' for learning and assessments with F.4 students. The discounted price is \$62.
