1. Study Tour for Citizenship and Social Development

The objectives and activities involved have been mentioned in the last school circular. Below are some details:

Date: 16th May, 2023 (Tuesday)

Location: Zhuhai, Aifeike Hangkong

Assemble at: 8:00 a.m., Lower School Hall

Dismiss at: 6:00 p.m., Kin Sang Estate

Diet: Individual meal sets (Aifeike Hangkong)

Dress code: School P.E. uniform

Reminders:

- a) Students should bring along their valid travel documents (Hong Kong Identity Card and Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macao Residents)
- b) Students need to complete the health declaration after 4:00 p.m. on 15th May (the QR code is valid within 24 hours). They should also complete RAT and receive the negative result. Use weChat to search for the service for travelers or access to the hyperlink below:

Capture the QR code. Custom officers may request the proof. The policy of health declaration may be adjusted and you are advised to pay attention to the latest arrangement released by the authority.
- c) Students should wear masks in the tour.

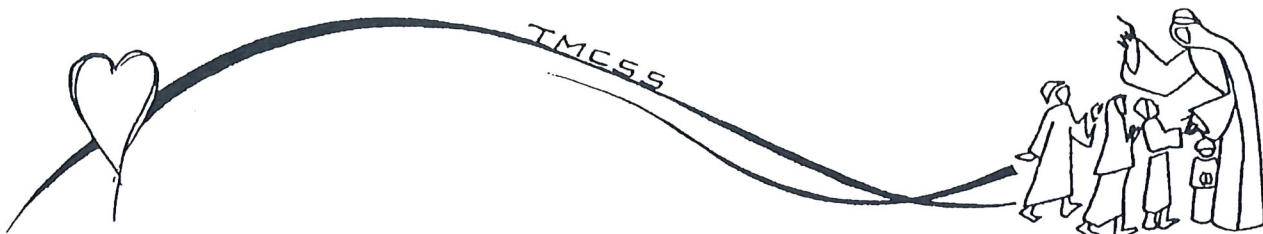


2. Final Examination

To evaluate the learning progress, the final examination will be held from 6th to 15th June. 16th June is the fallback day for the exam. Please refer to the attached exam timetable. You are advised to encourage your son or daughter to study hard so as to consolidate their knowledge.

3. Repeaters and Re-Examination

- a) Students with exam result around the bottom 10 will have to attend the makeup-examination. The subjects include Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics and Science. The priority for getting promoted relies on their makeup-exam results and the lowest 6 to 8 students will have a higher chance to repeat next year.
- b) Students involved in the makeup-examination will have to attend a revision class from 11th July



to 31st July between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. If students are late for more than 30 minutes, they will be considered absent. If students have an attendance rate lower than 80%, they are not allowed to attend the makeup-examination. Parents are advised not to arrange activities including travel or family visits in this period of time.

c) Students who do not attend the makeup-examination will repeat the level directly.

d) Important information:

- There is only one paper for each subject. Each paper lasts for 1 hour. The assessment lies on how students do revision and prepare for the exam.
- The makeup-exam will take place on 1st August. The makeup-exam timetable will be published on eClass soon.
- The result will be released on 4th August. Students can get the result slip from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on 4th August.
