It aims to encourage students to do more exercise especially under the pandemic and nurture them to keep a habit for doing sports leading to a healthy lifestyle. 1. Background

Hong Kong Catholic Diocese has served Hong Kong for 180 years, aiming at spreading Jesus's gospel and his teaching on love and care to residents from all walks of life. In the coming 10 years, in order to reconstruct and renovate some churches and foster development for better services, a huge budget is needed. Saint Joseph's Church in Fanling is under renovation and it is estimated that the cost is around 300 million dollars. The initial planning for building a church in Tung Chung has been finalized. To accomplish all items in the developmental plan, Hong Kong Catholic Diocese has established Diocesan Fund-raising Commission for Church Building and Development for handling the donation. 3. Rope skipping


