1. Educational Research run by University of Cambridge on Values Education

Our school has been invited to participate in a research study on values education conducted by the University of Cambridge, with the aim of exploring the impact of values education in Hong Kong on the behavioral development of adolescents. Students from Form 2 to Form 5 will be asked to complete a 20-minute questionnaire at school. All questionnaires and data collected will be anonymous and kept confidential. We hope that students will actively participate in this research as it can help the government and relevant non-governmental organizations integrate resources and implement effective policies and activities.

2. Seasonal influenza vaccination programmes

The school has participated in the Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach (Free of Charge) Programme of the Hong Kong Government which provides vaccines (injectable type). The vaccination date is on 15th December. The school will distribute the Consent Forms in late October. 3. Sale of Caritas Raffle Tickets

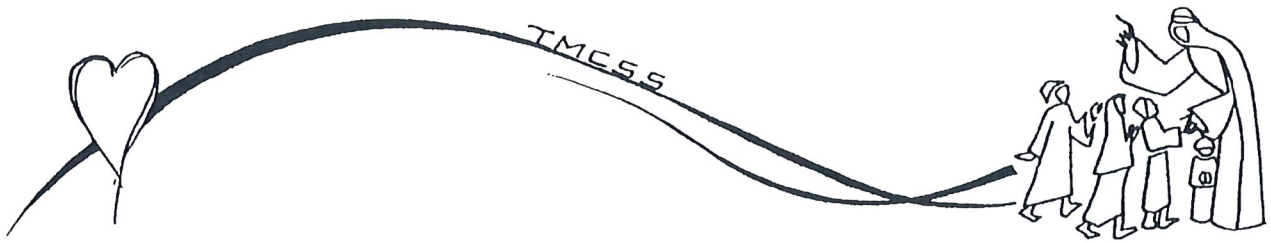

Date: 6th November, 2023 (Monday)

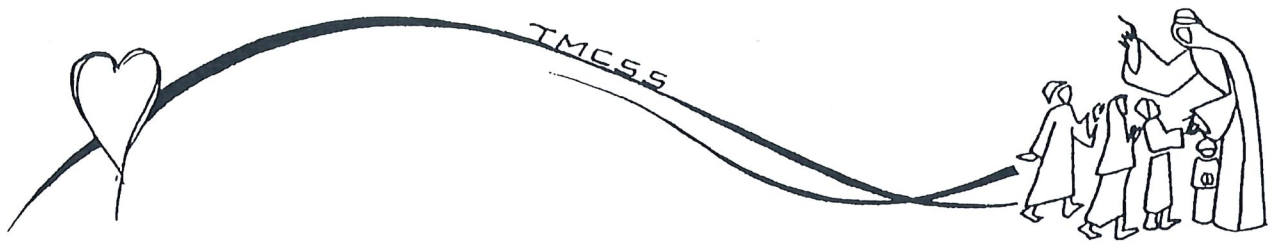
Location: Ocean Park

Dismissal time: 4:30 p.m.



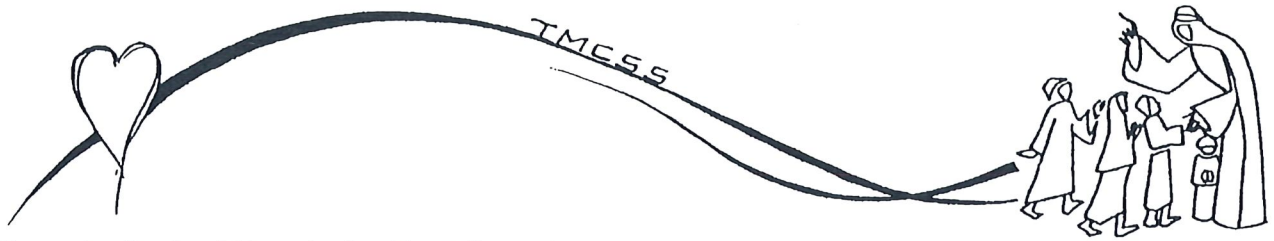
