Dear parents and guardians,

Territory-wide System Assessment, Exam Paper Review Period, online final exam mark checking, purchase of summer holiday assignments and the selection of F.4 elective subjects and the release of the class allocation results

Please pay attention to the following items:

1. Territory-wide System Assessment

On 19 June (Thursday) and 20 June (Friday), Form 3 students will take the territory-wide system assessments for Chinese Language, English Language, and Mathematics according to the following schedule:

The territory-wide system assessment is very important for the school to review students' academic performance. Parents are kindly encouraged to support their children in doing their best in these assessments.

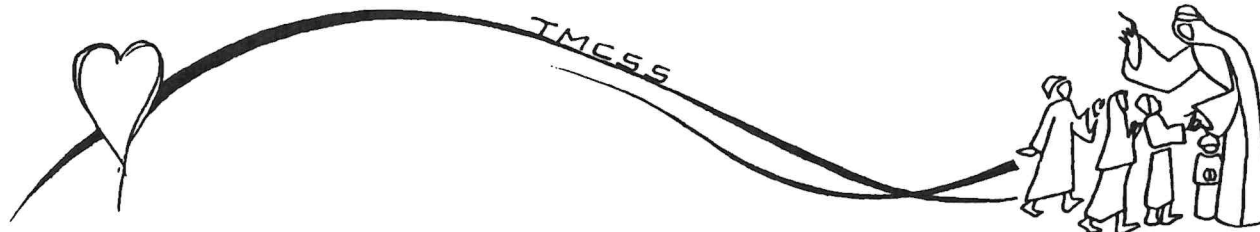
2. Exam Paper Review Period

23 June to 25 June are designated as exam paper review period for Form 3 students, providing an opportunity for students to understand their exam performance. The school timetable during these days is as follows:

The detailed schedule for each subject's review sessions will be posted in the school lobby on the ground floor and uploaded to eClass. Please check it accordingly. Should classes be suspended due to typhoons, heavy rainstorms, or other unforeseen circumstances, the review sessions for that day will be canceled and not rescheduled. Otherwise, the report cards cannot be issued on schedule on 16 July.





3. Online final exam mark checking

After marking and entering the grades on 25 June, an online link for mark checking will be made available on eClass on the morning of 30 June. Students can log in using their personal passwords to check their results. If there are any questions or corrections, students must contact their subject teachers before 12:00 noon on 2 July.

4. Purchase of summer holiday assignments

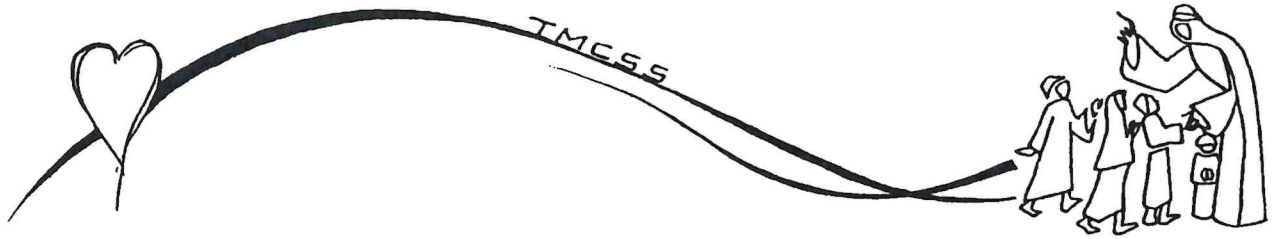
To help students review and consolidate their knowledge, the school has selected the following practice exercises as summer homework. Regardless of whether students are promoted or repeating their grade, all students are required to complete the summer assignments for each subject. Union New Retail (Hong Kong) Limited will offer these practice books at a special price for sale on 16 July at the lower hall. Students may bring cash to purchase on-site or choose to buy them at other bookstores.

Parents are kindly asked to encourage their children to complete the assignments seriously. The scope of the summer holiday assignments for each subject will be announced later via eClass. Students must submit their completed summer assignments on Registration Day, 15 August. Regardless of promotion or repeating, all students must complete the summer assignments for each subject.

5. The selection of F.4 elective subjects and the release of the class allocation results

Form 3 students will attend a subject selection seminar at 11:00 a.m. on 2 July. On 3 July, the school will release an online link via eClass for students to verify their results. Students can download their mock report cards and refer to their subject rankings to choose three elective subjects. Parents will receive an electronic notice regarding subject selection on 3 July and must submit the reply slip by 6 July. Students who fail to complete the subject selection process on time will be randomly assigned to electives with available places. Students are encouraged to choose subjects based on their abilities and



interests, fully understanding the learning requirements of senior secondary electives, and to make careful choices to be assigned subjects appropriate to their capabilities.

For the 2025-2026 academic year, Form 4 will be divided into four classes based on the overall Form 3 results. Students with the best math results will be placed in class 4A, followed by those with the best English results in 4B. The remaining students will be evenly distributed between classes 4C and 4D. Subject selection results will be announced on 14 July, and class placements for all levels will be released on 15 July.
