Exam Paper Review Period, online final exam mark checking, the dropout of elective subjects, Abseiling

Please pay attention to the following items:

1. Exam Paper Review Period

23 June to 25 June are designated as exam paper review period for Form 5 students, providing an opportunity for students to understand their exam performance. The school timetable during these days is as follows:

The detailed schedule for each subject's review sessions will be posted in the school lobby on the ground floor and uploaded to eClass. Please check it accordingly. Should classes be suspended due to typhoons, heavy rainstorms, or other unforeseen circumstances, the review sessions for that day will be canceled and not rescheduled. Otherwise, the report cards cannot be issued on schedule on 16 July.


2. Online final exam mark checking

After marking and entering the grades on 25 June, an online link for mark checking will be made available on eClass on the morning of 30 June. Students can log in using their personal passwords to check their results. If there are any questions or corrections, students must contact their subject teachers before 12:00 noon on 2 July.

3. The dropout of elective subjects

Form 4 and Form 5 students may apply to drop one elective subject according to their individual needs. Before applying, students should carefully consider their university subject choices and abilities. University admissions and other further education pathways will take into account the weighted scores of applicants' chosen subjects as part of their assessment, so students must deliberate cautiously and discuss their decision with their class teachers and subject teachers. The Vice Principal of Learning and Teaching may arrange to interview students based on their applications for approval.





After the marking review on 25 June, Form 4 and Form 5 students will attend a subject dropout briefing to understand the school's arrangements. Students who wish to apply must complete the application form between 25 June and 7 July, including a letter explaining the reason for the request and a study plan after the elective subject is dropped. They should also reserve time to attend an interview with the Vice Principal of Learning and Teaching on 10 July.

4. Abseiling Activity

Form 5 students will soon face the public examinations next year. Through this activity, we hope to boost students' confidence and strengthen the sense of unity among classmates. This activity will involve recreational abseiling, allowing Form 5 students to descend from higher floors to the ground within the familiar school campus.

During the activity, participants will experience various high-altitude challenges with the support of their classmates. Throughout the process, participants are encouraged to overcome their limits, learn how to face difficulties and adversity, and develop a new source of motivation to tackle future challenges.



5. The first release of the score prediction for HKDSE

Form 5 students will sit for the Diploma Examination in 2026. To help students better understand their learning progress and plan their summer revision, the school will distribute the first predicted results of the Diploma Examination on 16 July. The second predicted results will be released after the first formal test in Form 6. Subject heads of Chinese Language, English Language, and Mathematics will meet with students whose results are unsatisfactory and their parents to provide guidance and support for their summer learning plans.


6. Summer Holiday Assignment
