Submission of Supporting Documents for Eligibility of Education Bureau Activity Subsidies or Grants and Student Health Service, English Musical, Club Activities, Student Union Election, Mainland Study Tour Information Collection for Citizenship and Social Development and Payment Notice

Please refer to the following items:

1. Submission of Supporting Documents for Eligibility of Education Bureau Activity Subsidies or Grants and Student Health Service

The previous school circular mentioned a survey for applying for Education Bureau activity subsidies or grants. Families receiving Comprehensive Social Security Assistance from the Social Welfare Department are requested to submit the relevant supporting documents to facilitate the school's processing of subsidy applications. If the relevant documents are not submitted, the school will assume that the family is not receiving Comprehensive Social Security Assistance from the Social Welfare Department.

The Department of Health provides health services for students, arranging for each student to receive a check-up at a health service center once a year. This year, completed application forms must be submitted through an online platform. Parents who wish to enroll their children are requested to use the following "school-exclusive online registration link/QR code" to submit the completed application forms online between September 8 and 21, 2025. 2. English Musical

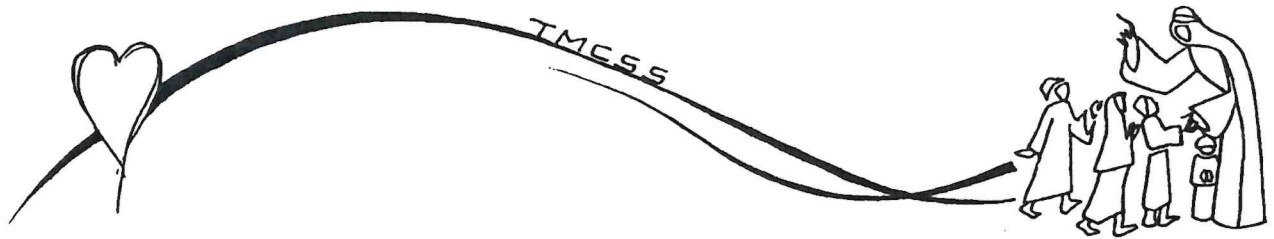


3. Club Activities

The club activities will officially commence on 29th September (Day 1, Monday).

Parents are kindly asked to remind their children to pay attention to announcements on eClass or during morning assemblies regarding clubs, and to check whether they have been approved as members of the respective clubs. Some clubs require interviews; parents and students should please pay close attention to the activity information.





4. Student Union Election

- ① The Student Union candidate cabinet Q&A session will be held on 23rd September (Day 6, Tuesday) during the assembly in the auditorium.
- ② The Student Union election voting will take place on 3rd October (Day 6) during periods 8 and 9. Students must follow the instructions of student helpers and vote in the hall. The Student Union is elected by a one-person-one-vote system and serves as a representative body that acts as a bridge between students and the school.

5. Mainland Study Tour Information Collection for Citizenship and Social Development

Citizenship and Social Development was launched for Form 4 students in the 2021/22 school year. According to the curriculum requirements, students must participate in at least one mainland study tour during the three years from Form 4 to Form 6. This experiential learning activity aims to achieve the course objectives. After completing the tour, students are required to conduct a project study to present their findings and personal reflections.

Our school tentatively plans the Form 5 mainland study tour for the 2025/26 academic year to take place in 20th -21st November 2025. The exact dates are yet to be confirmed by the Education Bureau. To facilitate the smooth organization of the activity, we need to collect students' information (please fill in the form using the QR code below). The information collected will be used solely for the arrangement of this study tour and will be destroyed after the activity.

Students must hold a valid Home Return Permit to participate in the tour. Those who have not yet obtained one or whose permits have expired are advised to apply for or renew their permits as soon as possible.

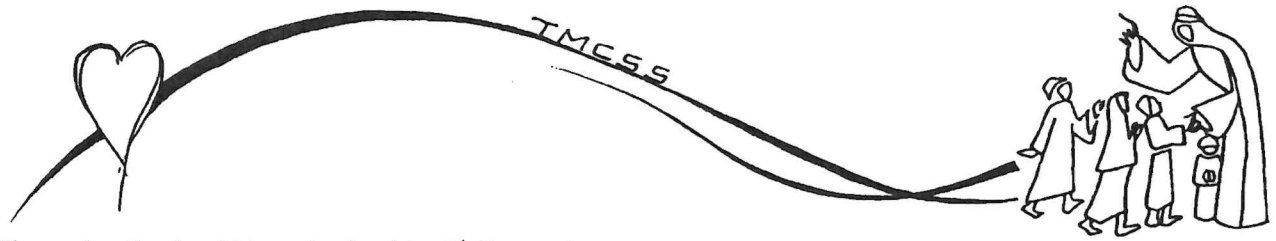
6. Payment Notice
