
## 1. Special Timetable

To accommodate the schedule of the Catholic Diocese Education Office, the originally scheduled school affairs meeting on 19<sup>th</sup> September has been rescheduled to 18<sup>th</sup> September. Classes on that day will follow a special timetable, with dismissal at 1:30 p.m. There will be no lunchbox storage service available. On 19<sup>th</sup> September, classes will follow the regular full-day timetable, with dismissal at 3:50 p.m.

Form 1 to Form 5 students will attend house assemblies on either 25<sup>th</sup> September or 26<sup>th</sup> September according to their assigned houses. On those days, the whole school will follow a special timetable, with dismissal at 1:30 p.m. Lunchbox storage service will be provided. Form 6 students are not required to attend house assemblies and may go home or stay in the library for study after morning classes.

On 6<sup>th</sup> October, the day of the Mid-Autumn Festival, classes will follow a special timetable, with dismissal at 1:30 p.m. The campus will remain open until 3:00 p.m. Lunchbox storage service will not be available on that day.





## 2. After-School Supplementary Classes for Senior Secondary

The senior secondary curriculum is intensive. To provide students with more time to consolidate their learning, subject teachers have arranged supplementary classes after school on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. Attendance is mandatory. Students who are unable to attend due to personal reasons must submit supporting documents and a parental letter to their class teacher at least three days in advance. If absent due to illness on the day of the remedial class, students must submit a parental letter and a medical certificate to the class teacher on the next school day. Absence without valid reason will be treated as truancy. Please refer to the attached timetable and review it carefully. For any questions, students may consult their subject teachers.

## 3. Outdoor Physical Education Classes


To provide students with a wider variety of sports activities, our school makes use of local sports facilities in the district whenever possible. Therefore, students may sometimes have physical education lessons outside the school campus. The rental fees for these venues are covered by the school. Students are expected to travel to and from the venue on their own, and dismissal will take place at the venue after the class. ## 4. Seasonal Influenza Vaccination Programme 2025-26

Our school is participating in the Government's "Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach (Free) Programme" to prepare for the flu season.
