# 1. <u>Visit to The Chinese University of Hong Kong Undergraduate Admission Information Day</u>

To enhance students' understanding of university subject choices and to better prepare for their future, the Career Guidance Team will lead students from Secondary 2 to Secondary 5 to visit The Chinese University of Hong Kong Undergraduate Admission Information Day. The details are as follows:

Time: 2:45 p.m. to 3:50 p.m.


Venue: School Hall

All students will follow the special timetable on that day, with lunch at 1:30 p.m. The tuck shop will operate as usual, and lunchbox storage services will be available as normal. Students should return to their classrooms by 2:35 p.m., where their class teachers will lead them to the hall.

#### 3. National Security Learning Day

The Hong Kong Special Administrative Region's first systematic exhibition hall on national security was officially established on 7<sup>th</sup> August, 2024. This exhibition hall is also the first physical national security education base in Hong Kong. To enhance students' understanding of the importance of national security, the Education Bureau has arranged for schools to organize visits to the exhibition





hall to complement related teaching activities.

Our school's visit arrangements are as follows:

Date: Wednesday, 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2025 (Day 6 lessons cancelled; students do not have to come back to school)

Time: Different classes have different meeting, dismissal, and visit times (please refer to the attached schedule for details)

Meeting and Dismissal Point: Outside the entrance of the Hong Kong Museum of History, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, 100 Chatham Road South, Tsim Sha Tsui, Hong Kong

Attire: Students must wear the proper school uniform on the day of the activity.

#### Activity detail:

Each class will participate in a 30-minute guided tour of the National Security Exhibition Hall according to their assigned time slot, followed by visits to the Hong Kong Museum of History's "80th Anniversary of the Victory of the War of Resistance" exhibition and the Hong Kong Science Museum. Students are required to complete online learning tasks during the visit. The entire activity will last approximately 3 hours. Please refer to the attachment for the detailed schedule.

## Transportation Arrangement:


Students are required to travel to the meeting point by their own means (Exit P2 of East Tsim Sha Tsui Station or Exit D1 of Hung Hom Station).


# 6. Catholic High School Singapore Teacher and Student Classroom Experience and Exchange Program

Catholic High School Singapore, established in 1935, is a Catholic boys' school whose alumni include Singapore's third Prime Minister, Mr. Lee Hsien Loong. After the pandemic, our school and Catholic High School have been conducting exchanges with teachers and students in both locations.

On 4<sup>th</sup> November, we will host their teachers and students for a Hong Kong school experience. Their students will attend classes together with our Form 2 and Form 3 students to engage in mutual exchange.

# 7. Details for Registration for the 78th Hong Kong Schools Music Festival

If students wish to register for the 78th Hong Kong Schools Music Festival, please refer to the HKSMSA website at https://hksmsa.org.hk/. Before the school registration deadline, please notify Ms. Cheng Zen In of the intended event codes (e.g., N150, W19) either at Staff Room 3 or via Teams. After the registration period, payment notices will be issued. Students must complete payment by the deadline; otherwise, the registration will be invalid.

School registration period: 22<sup>nd</sup> September to 17<sup>th</sup> October (This is the school's registration period, not the official festival registration period.)

Payment deadline: 24th October

# 8. Farmunity Hydroponics Learning Program

Starting from the 2024-2025 academic year, our school has introduced indoor hydroponics technology courses, aiming to foster students' abilities in scientific research exploration, business operations, and community care. The courses are designed for Secondary 3 students and jointly implemented by teachers of senior secondary elective subjects, including Biology, Chemistry, Economics, Business, Accounting and Financial Studies (BAFS), Health Management and Social Care, and Ethics and Religious Studies.

In the first term, each Secondary 3 student will receive 10 hours of training courses, with all fees fully subsidized by the school.


