Mainland Study Tour for the Citizenship and Social Development, Winter Uniform Change and Payment Notice

Please refer to the following items:

1. Mainland Study Tour for the Citizenship and Social Development

The mainland study tour is an important component of the Citizenship and Social Development curriculum. It aims to provide all senior secondary students with firsthand experience through onsite visits to enhance their understanding of the country's current situation and recent developments, deepen their appreciation of Chinese culture, and strengthen their sense of national identity. The Education Bureau prioritizes the arrangement of the "Citizenship and Social Development Mainland Study Tour" for Secondary 5 students.

All teachers and students participating in the tour will receive full funding from the Education Bureau. The funding covers the costs of visits, meals, transportation, and basic group travel insurance. Should any student choose to withdraw before departure, the student must bear any additional costs incurred due to the withdrawal. The Education Bureau may also revoke subsidies for that student, who would then be responsible for paying the relevant tour fees as well as any extra withdrawal charges. Only under special circumstances, such as illness (supported by a medical certificate) or other significant incidents preventing the student from joining the tour on time, will the Education Bureau consider maintaining the subsidy.

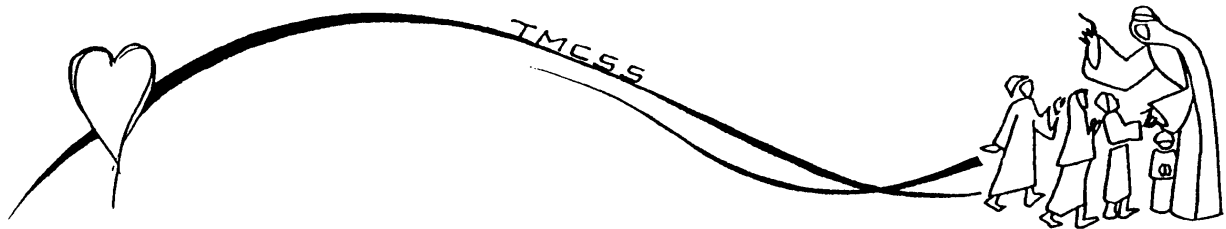
After completing the mainland study tour, students are required to conduct a project study and submit a personal report to the school. It is recommended that students familiarize themselves with the itinerary and points of interest before departure and gather relevant reference materials through different sources to complement and enrich their observations and reflections during the tour, thereby enhancing their project report.

The school will organize a briefing session for students on 24<sup>th</sup> October to remind them of important notices. Should there be any questions regarding the study tour, please feel free to contact Mr. Chan Sai Chiu, Head of the Citizenship and Social Development.

Participants: All Secondary 5 students

Accommodation: Zhonghao Yueji Hotel (Dongguan Humen Junlehui Branch) or other four-star standard hotels

Assembly Time and Place: 20<sup>th</sup> November, 7:30 a.m., school hall

Return Time and Dismissal Place: 21<sup>st</sup> November, around 7:45 p.m., dismissed at Kin Sang Estate

Dress Code: Winter sportswear (Day 1), casual wear (Day 2)

Remarks: Students must bring valid travel documents (Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card and Home Return Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents)

For details regarding payment items, please refer to Payment Notice No. 4. The payment notice will be distributed to parents together with the school newsletter at the beginning of the month.

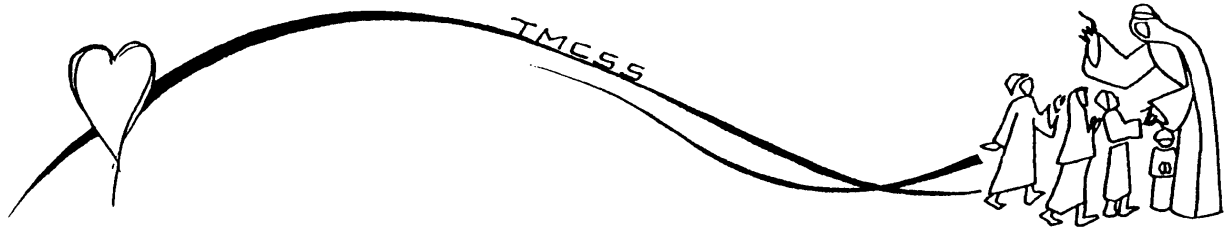
