





Founded in 1987, our school has developed steadily in the district thanks to the support of parents and the community, as well as the joint efforts of teachers and students. Students have achieved excellent results both academically and in extracurricular activities. To adapt to the development of the Medium of Instruction (MOI) Fine-tuning Policy and meet the learning needs of different students, we





have adopted English as the medium of instruction since the policy was implemented by the Education Bureau in 2010. In response to the Education Bureau's requirements for the third cycle of the MOI Fine-tuning Policy, we have added one more English-medium class (for all subjects) per junior secondary grade since 2022. Currently, 75% of our Secondary 1 students are enrolled in English-medium classes.


