1. Switching to Winter School Uniforms

Starting from 17th November, students may switch to winter school uniforms based on weather conditions. Uniform requirements can be found on pages 8 and 9 of the student handbook. Details are as follows:

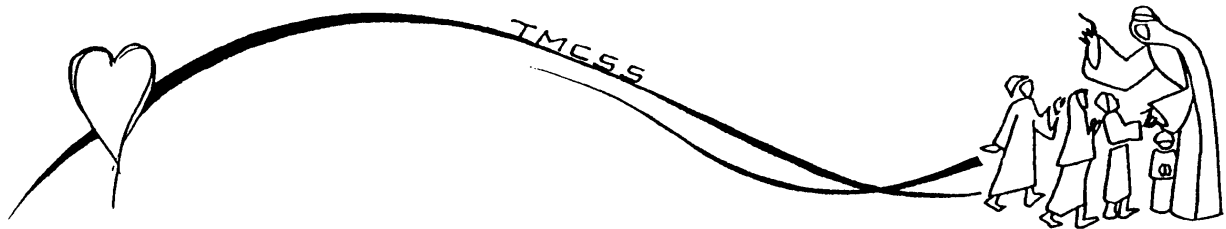
Date	Arrangements
Monday, 17 th November	Students may wear either winter or summer uniforms (PE uniforms must be brought to school for changing).
Tuesday, 9 th December	All students must switch to winter uniforms.

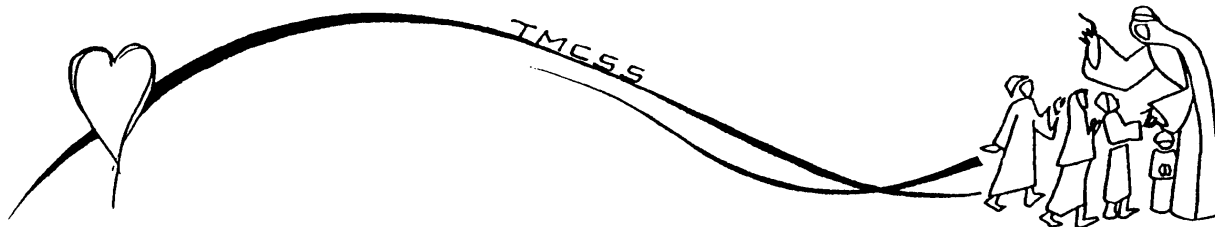
3. Secondary 1 Discretionary Place Online Application

Our school is a Catholic secondary school in the district, widely recognized and trusted by parents. For the 2026/27 Secondary 1 Discretionary Place application, physical application forms will not be available. Please complete the online application form via the school website during the specified period.

Application Submission Period: 2nd January, 2026 – 16th January, 2026.

Founded in 1987, our school has developed steadily in the district thanks to the support of parents and the community, as well as the joint efforts of teachers and students. Students have achieved excellent results both academically and in extracurricular activities. To adapt to the development of the Medium of Instruction (MOI) Fine-tuning Policy and meet the learning needs of different students, we





have adopted English as the medium of instruction since the policy was implemented by the Education Bureau in 2010. In response to the Education Bureau’s requirements for the third cycle of the MOI Fine-tuning Policy, we have added one more English-medium class (for all subjects) per junior secondary grade since 2022. Currently, 75% of our Secondary 1 students are enrolled in English-medium classes.

Class Type	Junior Secondary	MOI Arrangement
English-medium (All Subjects)	3 classes per junior grade	All subjects are taught in English, except Chinese Language, Chinese History, Putonghua, Life and Society, Reading, and Religious and Moral Education.
English-medium (Core Subjects)	1 class per junior grade	English Language, Mathematics, and Science are taught in English.

4. Blood Donation Drive

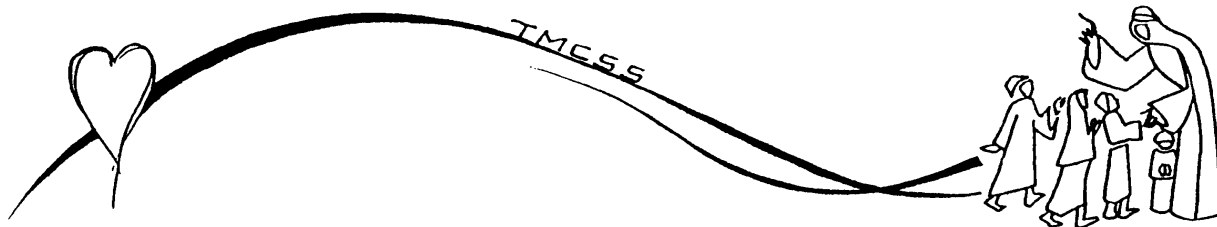

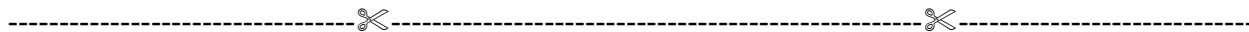
