Venue: School basketball court


Fee: Free of charge

3. Making Good Use of the Diploma Examination Preparation Holiday

This year's F.6 students will begin the Diploma Examination preparation holiday from 13<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 (Friday). There will be no classes to allow students to focus on their revision. Subject teachers have also prepared group revision sessions, tutorial classes, Speaking Training for Paper 4 of the English Language subject, and preparatory assessments.

In addition, students may return to school on school days to study in the library and meet with teachers for individual guidance. Last year's graduates made good use of the Diploma Examination





preparation holiday and achieved satisfactory results, with over 60% of them admitted to local universities through the Joint University Programmes Admissions System. Beyond exam results, students benefited greatly from the encouragement and experiences shared by peers and teachers, which helped them overcome difficulties and grow personally. Parents are encouraged to support students in making frequent contact with teachers during the Diploma Examination preparation holiday to progress together.


