Dear Parents and guardians,

Trial on elective subject selection, First Term Academic and Conduct Award Presentation and Parents' Day and Holiday and Shifting the exam language into English

Please refer to the following items:

1. Trial on elective subject selection

The school will release an online link for checking grades on eClass on 6th Feb (Friday). Students can download the simulated report card and use the overall ranking in each subject to conduct the trial run on subject selection. Parents are requested to discuss with their children the desired elective subjects for senior secondary education. The students should submit their order of preference for subjects within each elective group to the school via an electronic reply form between 7th Feb and 8th Feb.

The results of the subject selection simulation are for the reference of parents and students only. The simulation is based solely on the student's academic performance in the previous semester and does not guarantee the allocation of the same elective subjects in the official subject selection in July.

2. First Term Academic and Conduct Award Presentation


The First Term Conduct and Academic Award Ceremony will be held on 3rd March (Day 6) during periods 8 to 9. At the ceremony, awards such as Outstanding Academic Achievement Awards, Subject Awards, and Conduct Awards will be presented to students who have performed excellently in various aspects. It also aims to encourage other students to continue their efforts.

3. Parents' Day and Holiday

The school has scheduled Parents' Day on 8th March (Sunday) and sincerely invites parents to come at the designated time on that day to collect the report cards. The class teacher will later inform your child of the meeting time. Please ensure that your child is dressed in neat school uniform to accompany the parents. Besides meeting with the class teacher, discussions about the student's education and life situation can also take place to enhance mutual communication. The day following Parents' Day, 9th March (Monday), will be a holiday for the school, and there will be no classes.

To review the current state of school development, the school invites parents to fill out a questionnaire on Parents' Day. The school will use the collected data to promote self-evaluation and pursue excellence.





4. Shifting the exam language into English

Parents must notify the school in writing from now on until 29th May regarding the application to change the examination language of subjects taught in Chinese to English. The school will consider the student's overall academic performance, English proficiency, background of the English teaching environment, and grades in related subjects in junior secondary elective subjects. The Vice Principal of Learning and Teaching and the subject head will meet with the parents and the student to further discuss the application and the school's approval decision.
