1 Hong Kong Schools Music Festival

The Hong Kong Schools Music Festival is the biggest annual event in the music curriculum for schools. Since last year, our school's music department has organized Form 1 students to represent the school in the choir competition, allowing students to learn choral skills and team spirit, as well as providing an opportunity for musical exchange with other schools, broadening their horizons and enhancing their sense of belonging to the school.

This year, Form 1 students will continue to be divided into boys' and girls' choirs, each participating in English and Chinese choral events. After last year's experience, most Form 2 students are willing to take on the challenge this year and participate in the more difficult mixed choir group. Details of the three competitions are attached. Please send your encouragement to Form 1 and Form 2 students.


Form 2 Mixed Choir (73 Form 2 students)



2. Invitation to Book Fair and Authors Sharing Sessions

Tuen Teen Book Fair is our traditional annual event, in which teachers recommend books and introduce different authors and genres. We aim to nurture students with good reading habits and widen their horizons.

Our theme is 'Books enrich your mind, virtues nourish your life'. Books including Chinese Language, English Language, Language Across Curriculum are available. The books cover topics such as Religious Studies, Literatures, Humanities, Natural Science and so on. Parents are also advised to read books about parent-child communication, information technology, cooking, planting and so on.





20% off is offered to Chinese books and 15% off is offered to English books. There are also books with special discounts.


