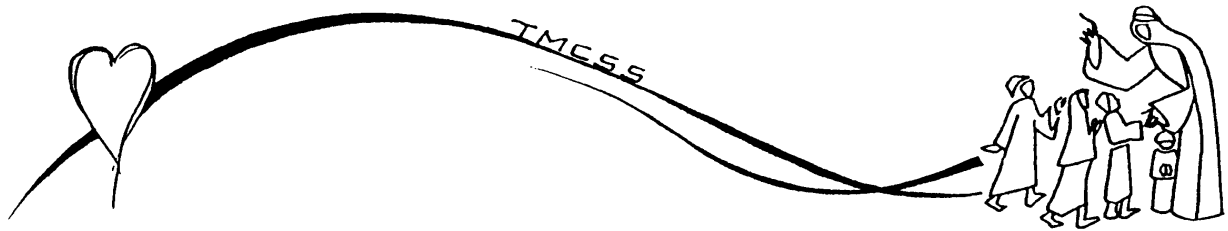
3. English Talent Show Rehearsals and Performance

6. Payment Notice

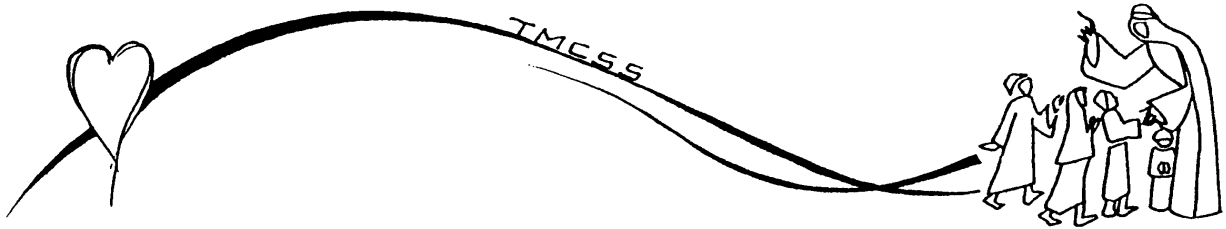
Regarding payment items, please refer to the details in Payment Notice No. 8. This notice is being distributed to parents along with this month's school circular.
