1. Submission of Supporting Documents for Eligibility of Education Bureau Activity Subsidies or Grants

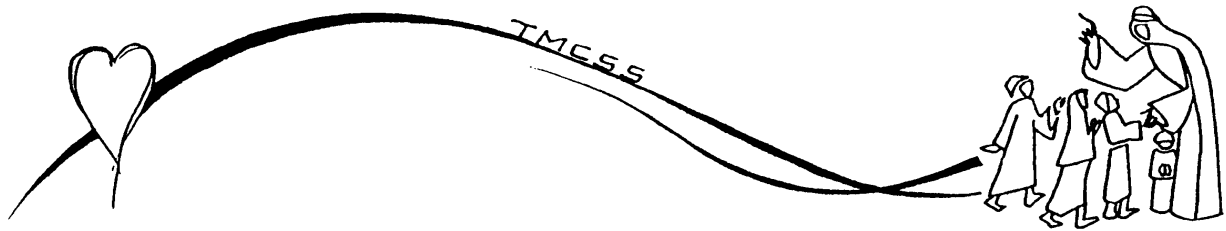


Option B: Paper Enrolment

6. Revision of Secondary Two Curriculum

Our school has been optimizing its school-based curriculum to catch up with the development of Digital Education and STEAM curriculum. The junior secondary STEAM curriculum will be fully implemented in the 2026/27 school year. There will be two STEAM lessons per cycle in the Secondary 2 STEAM course. Secondary 2 students, who will be divided into two groups, will take the course in either the first or second term within the same academic year.

Additionally, our school will introduce a learning skill course for Secondary 2 students to strengthen their self-directed and AI-assisted learning capabilities. The curriculum covers note-taking techniques, AI study tools, learning portfolio management, and subject-specific learning skills for English.
