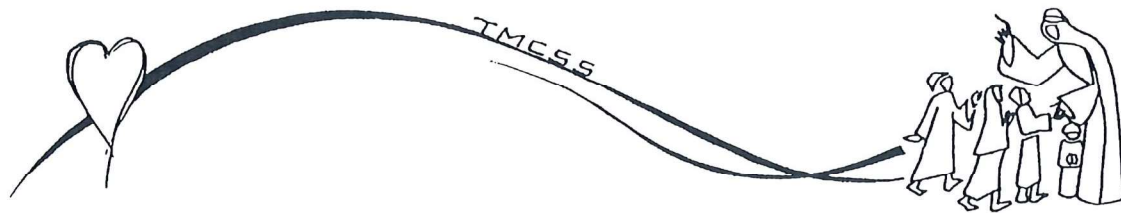
Dear alumni,
